Holy Week Timeline



Sunday

- Jesus enters the eastern gate on a donkey with crowds waving palm branches shouting Hosanna!

Monday

- Jesus clears the temple of money changers, animal dealers, and other merchants.

Tuesday

- Jesus teaches at the Temple for the last time running into a confrontation with both Pharisees and Sadducees.

Wednesday

- Judas conspires to betray Jesus.

Thursday

- Jesus washes His disciples' feet.
- He shares the Last Supper with His disciples.

Friday

- Jesus takes His disciples to Gethsemane to pray, where He is identified by Judas kissing Him on the cheek, and then arrested.
- He is taken to trial before the High Priests and Sanhedrin, and convicted before dawn.
- Needing Roman permission to execute Him, they take Him before Pilate who sends Him to Herod. (6AM)
- Herod wants no part of this after receiving political fallout over the execution of John the Baptist, and sends him back to Pilate.
- After a political maneuver fails, Barrabas is released, and Jesus is sentenced to death. (8AM)
- After carrying His own cross, He is nailed to the cross (9AM), where He remains until He dies. (3PM)
- Nicodemus and Joseph of Arimathea bury Him in a nearby tomb that is sealed before sundown. (6PM)

Saturday

- Jesus lies in a guarded, sealed tomb.

Sunday
